

# Rape-diary defense

A Queens man convicted of raping his wife's teenage sister says the girl's diary tells a different story.

Luis Gomez, 36, who faces seven years in prison at sentencing today in a Queens court, plans to cite a June 2003 entry in the girl's diary, where the writer details an encounter with a boyfriend during which she lost her virginity.

"She never mentions anything about Luis raping her or touching her," said Gomez's lawyer, Robert DiDio. "She complains about everything else in her life."

Gomez has been locked away on Rikers Island for 18 months. He is awaiting trials on similar charges with the same girl in Brooklyn and Florida, where they lived briefly.
