

Vic diary blows sex case - att'y

IN A BOMBSHELL revelation on the eve of sentencing, the lawyer for convicted sex molester Luis Gomez yesterday contended that a newly discovered diary kept by his client's victim shows she had sex with at least six boys by the time she was 14.

Attorney Robert Didio said he will ask for a new trial for Gomez, who was convicted Aug. 29 in Queens Supreme Court of sexually abusing his sister-in-law since 1998, when she was 8 years old.

"We weren't aware of this diary until it ended up on my desk from a family member," the lawyer said. "My client's liberty is at stake. His name has been destroyed both personally and in public. He has maintained his innocence since day one."

Didio quotes from a passage in the diary in which the girl writes she lost her virginity to a boy

identified as Josh when she was 13.

"I think I just made the biggest mistake of my life and this is real," the girl allegedly wrote. "I just ... u no ... lost my, u no what, to Josh."

According to the attorney, the victim wrote on Feb. 18, 2004: "It's less than a year b4 I lost my virginity and already I've had five sexual partners and I'm only 14."

Gomez, 36, who lives in Florida, was convicted of sexual abuse, sexual misconduct against a child and child endangerment based on the sole testimony of the girl.

She testified that Gomez began abusing her when she was 8 and that she was raped between the summer of 2001 and December 2002.

Gomez faces up to seven years in prison.

His lawyer said he is filing a last-minute motion reversal. The Queens district attorney's office had no immediate comment.
